SAT Practice Test

Saturday, March 20, 2010, 8:30am

A full-length practice SAT test will be given at Aviation High School on Saturday, March 20, 2010, at 9:00am (arrive by 8:30am to check in). This is open to all Aviation High School students for a nominal cost of \$10 and all proceeds go to the PTA. By taking a full-length practice SAT in real time, simulating the actual experience; students learn what an actual SAT test is like and learn what *taking* an SAT is really like. The practice test is timed and proctored, just like the real thing. Students get a detailed score report so they can identify their strengths and weaknesses and create an effective study plan. The test will be analyzed and scored by The Princeton Review and a free workshop will be given to parents and students to discuss the results on Thursday, March 25, 2010, at 5:30pm. This test will serve only as a benchmark so students and parents can better understand the structure of the test and the types of questions to expect. The scores will not be sent to any colleges. Students should bring their own calculator to the test. Any type of calculator (4-function or graphing) is fine.

Those wishing to take the SAT practice test are required to **register in advance** with Ms. Cuervo-Digiorgio by March 8, 2010. Please bring \$10 in cash or money order made payable to "Aviation HS PTA" (non-refundable). Space is limited.
